

2007 FEI WORLD DRESSAGE CHALLENGE

The "Clinic" is open to the **12 best-placed riders** (according to their results in percentages) out of PSG, Test A and/or Test B + **to the 4 best Children** if any. If there are no Children or less than 4, the vacant places may be taken by adults up to the number of 16. The riders with the same horses will receive a training based on the test they performed the previous day (Competition day).

The "Clinic" is **only** open to the Challenge Riders + **4 Children**. A rider/horse is only allowed to start once in the "Clinic".

CLINIC

Aim of the Clinic:

- **The judges will aim to improve the way of going and work on the general weaknesses shown in the execution of the test. This may involve work on the basics or repeating certain movements performed in the competition.**
- **This part of the Clinic should be shared with other riders and national judges & trainers in order to create uniformity and help develop the understanding and execution of dressage.**
- **Riders may find it helpful to have their training session and comments videoed.**

VIDEO SESSION OR GENERAL DISCUSSION

If time permitted, the traditional video session open to the 16 riders qualified for the Clinic **OR** an open general discussion on all sorts of questions relating to Dressage should take place, whenever possible, directly after the Challenge Competition (competition day).

Since video sessions are considered very valuable for the riders and trainers, we strongly encourage all OCs to organize such a session.
