FEI Pony Riders Committee Meeting Report Jaszkowo (POL), 2 August 2004

The Pony Riders Committee held its annual meeting in on August 2, following the European Pony Championships in Jaszkowo (POL). Whilst dealing with general matters such as the appointment of Officials for the 2005 European Championships in Italy and report on the Euro Pony Club General Assembly some of the items of which were decided by the Committee were the following:

Replacement of Members

The committee expressed their gratitude to the two members due to step down in 2005, Mr Anthony McPherson and Dr Barnabas Mandi. The committee then discussed the received applications and proposals to replace those outgoing members. The members unanimously agreed to nominate to the Bureau Ms Jean Mitchell (IRL) and Mrs Francis Verbeek-Von Rooy (NED) to replace Mr McPherson and Dr Mandi.

Revision of the Rules 2006

The principal part of the meeting was taken up by a full review of the existing Rules for Pony Riders which were to be revised for 2006. After completion of the review the proposed draft rules were to be sent out to all NFs for their comments and then presented to the FEI Bureau meeting in November.

New Dressage tests for Pony Eventing

It was decided that the new FEI Eventing dressage tests for 2005 would be reviewed by Mr McPherson and Ms Mitchell to establish their suitability for ponies. If suitable, the tests would be in force as from 1/1/2005.
