

ANNEX XIII PRESENTATION OF RESULTS

1. Reference is made to the Final Results sheet given in Annex VI.
2. From time to time the FEI gives out guidance on other information to be available on the final results sheet - for example breeding of the horse.
3. The FEI requires a copy of the final results in order to be able to maintain its results database.
4. The FEI has determined the sequence to be used in the Final Results to show horses that do not finish the competition. It is as follows:
 1. Eliminated Jumping
 2. Retired Jumping
 3. Eliminated 3rd Horse Inspection
 4. Withdrawn before Horse Inspection
 5. Eliminated Cross Country
 6. Retired Cross Country
 7. Withdrawn Cross Country
 8. Eliminated Dressage
 9. Withdrawn after Dressage
 10. Eliminated 1st Horse Inspection
 11. Withdrawn 1st Horse Inspection
5. Tie Breakers in case of equality in points in final classification (Art 502.2)
 1. best overall Cross country test score
 2. best score on the Cross Country obstacle phase (obstacles + time penalties)
 3. competitor Cross Country Obstacle phase time closest to the optimum time
 4. competitor whose steeplechase time closest to the optimum time
 - if still equality, then a tie shall be declared

In Olympic Games the following tie breakers will be added:

 5. Best individual Jumping score (time & Obstacles)
 6. lowest obstacle penalties
 7. best (fastest) of the Individual Jumping
 - if still equality, then a tie shall be declared
