REINING NEWS!!

We are hereby pleased to send you some news regarding decisions taken at the recent FEI Reining Committee meeting in Manerbio (ITA).

- 1. Final date for qualification to FEI World Reining Masters Final 2005.**
The last date for qualification for the Final in Manerbio (ITA), to be Sunday 28th August and the deadline for entry submission to be Monday 29 August, 2005.
- 2. FEI Reining Stewards and Veterinarians.** As there is a shortage of FEI Reining Stewards and FEI Reining Veterinarians for International reining events, National Federations are strongly encouraged to train and approve more Stewards for Reining and also to have more Veterinarians on the list for Reining. The FEI is also planning to hold a Stewards course for reining stewards later this year. Invitation to be sent out separately and also be posted on the FEI website.
- 3. Courses.** The FEI would like to encourage NFs to organise more Judges' Courses for Reining. We would be happy to receive applications for both 2005 and 2006. Please address your applications to Anna Milne, Reining Department a.milne@horsesport.org
- 4. Rule Changes 2006.** Subject to FEI Bureau approval the following changes will be made as from 1 January 2006.

Classification of CRIs

Art 301. 1.3.

CRI-B with price money less than CHF 2.400	Rename CRI 1*
CRI-B with price money CHF 2.401-8.999	Rename CRI 2*
CRI-A with price money CHF 9.000-12.000	Rename CRI 3*
CRI-A with price money more than CHF 12.000	Rename CRI 4*

Art 301.2

CRIO with price money less than CHF 12.000 Rename **CRIO 3***

CRIO with price money more than CHF 12.000 Rename **CRIO 4***

Number of Judges in Ground Jury at CRIs.

Art 309.

CRI 1* Minimum 1 FEI Judge, which does not need to be foreign

CRI 2* Minimum of 2 FEI Judges, which does not need to be foreign

CRI/CRIO 3* Minimum of 3 FEI Judges, one of which shall be foreign

CRI/CRIO 4* 5 FEI Judges, at least two must be foreign

In respect of the appointment of Judges for CRIs/CRIOs the FEI will consider waivers to the present Rules, if requested, to Organising Committees as from June 1, 2005.
