FEI JUMPING RIDERS' WORLD RANKING LIST – 2008
OLYMPIC GAMES



The FEI Olympic Riders Ranking – Jumping, covering the period of **1 January 2007 to 1 May 2008** will be used to determine respective qualification. The list is restricted to the 30 best results per rider.

Generals

For the purpose of qualifying for the Olympic Games, the number of competitions to count will be limited to 30. Conditions for qualifying for the Olympic Games are laid down in the Rules for Equestrian Events at the Olympic Games.

The FEI Jumping Riders' World Ranking list takes into account the points obtained from 1 January 2007 until 1 May 2008.

The FEI Jumping Riders' World Ranking list is produced by the FEI Secretariat.

The ranking list is updated weekly but is released on the first week of each month only. The updated version during the month is not published or distributed, except for specific purposes (World Cup invitations, selection for Top Ten Final etc).

Point System

Competitions are divided into groups depending on their level. *Refer to definition of Groups.*

For Individual competitions, riders obtain points related to their placing in the competitions. The scale of points differs from one group to the other. *Refer to scales of points.*

For Team competitions, riders obtain points related to their results. If they obtain four penalty points or less in at least one of the rounds, they earn points. *Refer to Nations Cup.*

For main Championships, riders placed in the first three (or four) obtain bonus points in addition to the points obtained during the competitions. *Refer to bonus.*

The 16 best placed competitors (plus the riders tying for the last place to count) will obtain points in all individual competitions counting for the ranking. Points won by riders who are tied are added up and divided equally among them. Two decimals are kept. The second decimal place will be rounded up from .005 and rounded down from .004.

Riders placed more than once in the first 16 obtain points for their best placing only.

Competitions excluded: Knock-out, puissance, six bar, relay, team competition other than Nations Cup and show or special competitions.

There will be no limit on the number of competitions per event which count for the world ranking list provided they meet the criteria of a group.

Horse/Rider Combination Ranking list

In accordance with the above rules a ranking list for the Horse/Rider Combination is established each year. If one of the two elements forming the combination changes during the year, the points start again from scratch. This list begins for each combination with zero point on 1 January and finishes on 31 December (only the points of the current year are taken into account; there is no carry over of previous championships or Games points).
